Learning Options Available during the 2020-2021 School Year

During registration you will have to select your choice of learning environment for your child.

Face to Face Instruction (traditional instruction)	Remote Learning Instruction
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• OISD will be providing Face to Face, traditional instruction on campus and has implemented safety protocols to create the safest learning environment possible. These are located on the OISD website under public notices.• Students will be required to take STAAR• Students may participate in UIL and other activities associated with the school. Activities will have safety protocols associated with each.• Masks, shields and/or social distancing will be required	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• OISD remote learning will be more rigorous than the end of year 2020. Requirements will be different and more comprehensive.• Students will follow the same expectations as those attending face to face instruction.• Students will be required to follow dress code and be ready to learn.• Students will be required to actively participate virtually using platforms such as zoom (this platform will be designated by the teacher)• Students failing to attend remotely will be marked absent and will be subject to truancy, failure and loss of credit.• Students will be required to take STAAR• The grading policy will be the same as the traditional, on campus instruction. The due dates, requirements and grading will be the same.• Students will not be able to participate in UIL or other activities associated with the school.

OISD believes that families choosing the remote instruction option have health concerns related to possible contact with others. Extracurricular activities require interactions with others; therefore, students participating in remote instruction **will not** participate in Extracurricular activities: Athletics, Band, Cheerleading, UIL Academics, FFA, One Act Play, Student Council and Culinary Arts, etc.

Students may choose remote instruction at any time but must remain in that instructional platform until the grading period.
