Charter members included Cecil Fox (TPWD), Charlie Kimmel (Dickens County Sheriff), Horace Cage (Dickens County Deputy), V.C. Smart (Spur Resident), Horace Wood (Ranch Owner – Dickens County Sheriff’s Posse), and J.R. Whitmire (Texas Highway Patrol). The purposes of the meetings were to focus on the need and benefits of cooperation in Law Enforcement. The Caprock Peace Officer Association was designed to facilitate competitive fun and fellowship amongst its members. The Caprock Peace Officers Association remains the predominant Law Enforcement Association designed to enhance interagency interaction in West Texas; while giving back to those we are entrusted to protect.
