
The Junior League of Lubbock offers a \$2,500 Volunteer Service Award Scholarship to a female high school senior who demonstrates an exemplary commitment to volunteerism in her community. Applications must be received by February 16, 2018, and may be submitted through the JLL website. The prerequisites for the scholarship include the following:

- Female
- High school senior
- College bound in the fall of 2018 (to either a two-year college or four-year university)
- Resident of Lubbock, Lamb, Hale, Floyd, Crosby, Garza, Lynn, Terry, or Hockley counties

The Community Impact Council of the Junior League of Lubbock reviews each application and makes a recommendation to the JLL Executive Board. The council makes its final decision on the highest cumulative score based on (1) volunteer activities, (2) demonstrated impact of volunteer efforts, (3) continued commitment to voluntarism, and (4) references. The \$2,500 scholarship is made payable to the college or university the recipient attends in fall 2017. JLL announces the award recipient by March 6, 2018.
