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<p>Develop staff skills to help families meet learning benchmarks</p>	<p>OISD's goal is to offer staff development to support teachers in helping families so that their children reach learning benchmarks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Offer staff development through ESC17 • Offer staff development through campus trainings addressing parent outreach activities • Offer staff development that encourages communication between teacher and parent • Individual parent/teacher conferences to discuss learning goals and progress toward meeting those goals using the language of the home.
