  - B. I attended a School Nurse Conference-I will attend another in June 2026
  - C. I have attended all the Texas Opioid Prevention classes for the virtual conference. I will be able to provide Opioid education to Secondary Campus
  - D. Monthly AED checks are still being completed by Nurse Kayla
  - E. 1<sup>st</sup> grade Fantastic Teeth education completed
  - F. I had a clinic visit from the DSHS Screening program coordinator and my clinic passed
  - G. PCT Skills Night was a success
- VI. New Business:
  - A. Fitness Grams will be completed this month
  - B. Color Run/Track and Field Day is in May 20<sup>th</sup>
  - C. Our students have improved their pacer times and push up progress in PE.
  - D. Oral Health Improvement Program-I met with them at the School Nurse Conference and they finally have a new Dentist so they will reach out to me next week to set up a time to come to Elementary. I have emailed and they are unsure if they have a date for this school year or if we need to plan for the Fall. They will get back to me.
  - E. Emergency Response Plan was updated and a mandatory Cardiac Emergency Response Plan was created by Nurse Kayla.
  - F. School Nurse has been working on updating care plans for our students with Chronic Conditions such as Asthma and Seizures.

- G. Our Principal and Counselor have been meeting with students as needed when we students that feel they need to talk with someone.
- H. The School Nurse has been checking immunization compliance and ensuring all new students are up to date. I will be sending out immunization need forms to parents. I will be sending letters out this month to parents whose children's immunization declination forms are expiring.
- I. I have been getting all of the incoming Pre-K student's immunization paperwork together
- J. Health Clinic Data: School Nurse sees anywhere from 15-25 students a day. The top reasonings being stomach aches.
- K. Injury trends: Our most frequent injury comes from student's bumping their heads on the monkey bars on the playground during recess. No severe injuries have occurred from this.
- L. I did make 1 Student Accident report last month for a possible arm fracture- no fracture ended up being found
- M. I did have 1 diagnosis of extreme heat exhaustion in a Kindergarten student- student did visit the ER. I have been educating the students on ways to prevent this from happening to them.
- N. School Nurse is still looking into grants for AED's. I have been approved for a reduced cost of AED's, but not any that will be fully covered.
- O. I completed the Triennial assessment for SHAC & Wellness Committee
