## **COVID Updates/Changes Report**

Some Covid protocol changes as of 8/1/2022– Following TEA guidelines

- Covid testing still available to staff & students if requested by staff member or parent – Written consent required – Testing done by school nurses – Heidi Cobb & Xandi Perez
- Strongly encourage parents not to send to school if their child has symptoms of Covid – Please allow 5 days off for this situation – This decision is up to the parent – We no longer have “Covid” days counted for absences – Just regular days absent
- Any Covid positive student or staff member is allowed 5 days off – Must be fever free & have improved symptoms – Again, any variations to this are up to the parent
- No longer require quarantine to persons exposed to Covid but display no symptoms
- All positive Covid tests done & confirmed in the school will be reported to the local Health Department by the school nurses
- School systems can no longer require staff or students to wear a mask. If desired, staff & students have the option to wear mask
