Seizure Management Protocol

The parent or guardian of a student with a seizure disorder may seek care for the student's seizures while the student is at school or participating in a school activity. The parent/guardian should submit a copy of a Seizure Management and Treatment Plan to the health services department of the campus the student attends. A treatment plan is available on the OISD website for the parent/guardian to use.

A School Nurse (RN) or other Patient Care Representative from the Health Care Services Department, must complete an approved course of instruction regarding managing student's with seizure disorders that includes information about seizure recognition and related first aid.

Other district employees whose duties at the school include regular contact with students must complete an agency approved course of instruction. This instruction will also include information about seizure recognition and related first aid.

If a seizure is suspected, notify Health Care Services staff. In their absence, notify EMS and parent/guardian. Remain calm and start timing seizure. Turn the student on their side. Don't restrain them and place no objects in their mouth. Protect their head.
